English:
Reading – Continuing Little Wandle & Big Cat Books in group reading
Writing – Core text: Somebody Swallowed Stanley – working towards writing a fact file. Focusing on using ‘and’ to join words, punctuation (exclamation and question marks) as well as suffixes –ed, -ing, -er, -est.
Handwriting – precursive
Phonics – Revision ahead of Phonics Screen
Spellings – applying phonics to spell and tricky words

Maths:
Place value (within 50)
 Grouping 10, partitioning 10s and 1s and number lines to 50.
Length and Height
 Comparing and measuring lengths and height
Mass and Volume
 Measuring and comparing mass and capacity.
Multiplication and Division
 Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, making representations of multiple equal groups

Science:
Plant Parts
 This project teaches children about wild and garden plants by exploring the local environment. They identify and describe the basic parts of plants and observe how they change over time.

RE:
Judaism– Who is Jewish and what do they believe?
 This investigation enables pupils to think about what might be found in a Jewish home and how these objects link to the Jewish way of life. There is a focus on the mezuzah, the belief in one God, Shabbat and Chanukah.

History:
School Days
 This project teaches children about their own school and locality, both today and in the past. They compare schooling in the Victorian era to their experiences today.

PSHE :
Relationships
 This topic will help children to understand more about friendships. They will learn how to make new friends and solve friendship problems when they occur. The children will know and be able to show what makes a good relationship thinking about respect and belonging.

Computing:
Improving mouse skills
 Within this topic the children will develop mouse skills by learning how to log in and navigate around a laptop while creating digital artwork.
Digital imagery
 This topic will develop the children’s photography and image editing skills to capture photos to create an adventure story.

PE - Inside
Jumping
 In this unit of work the focus of learning is to consolidate pupils jumping and to apply an effective jumping technique in a variety of games. The children will understand how to apply the correct technique for jumping, skipping and hopping in games and gain knowledge of how, where and why we jump in a game. Pupils will explore jumping using different combinations, jumping for distance and speeds.

PE - Outside
Sports Day activities
 The children will practise skills required for the variety of activities they will complete on sports day.
 They will focus on running, throwing, dribbling and team game.

Art:
Collagraphy
 This project teaches children about collagraph printing, including how to develop a motif to make single and repeated prints.
