

 <p>Class: Elderberry</p> <p>Term 3 2025-26</p>	<p>English Core Text-The Dragon Machine. Reading-Little Wandle/Big Cat Books in group reading. The children will also continue with comprehension skills lessons. Writing- The children will learn how about different sentence types and how to punctuate them. They will learn how to use 'because' and 'when' to link ideas and which verb endings are needed for the past and present tense. Spelling-Will include further focus on phonics and tricky words including how to use an apostrophe. The children will be working on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p> <p>Measurement Money- including making amounts with coins and notes and calculating change.</p>
<p>Science Uses of Materials This project teaches children about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. They begin to explore how materials can be changed.</p>	<p>Geography-Coastline This project teaches children about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.</p>	<p>Art The whole school will be working on a project: Pattern from African Cultures.. Key stage 1 will be focussing on Chitenge Patterns from Malawi.</p>
<p>PSHE-Dreams and Goals The children will discuss setting realistic goals and how they can achieve them. They will discuss perseverance when they find things difficult as well as recognising their strengths as a learner. They will talk about group work and reflect on who they work well with and who they don't. They will also talk about sharing success with other people.</p>	<p>R.E.-Humanism The children will learn that Humanism isn't a religion, but a way of thinking and living. In the topic the children will explore how Humanists believe that this is our only life and it is very important to live a worthwhile, happy life for ourselves and others. They will learn how this might look in relationships and in the natural world.</p>	<p>Computing-Programming: Algorithms & Debugging The children will learn what an algorithm is and explore how an algorithm is constructed to make a program. They will create simple algorithms and learn how what abstraction and debugging means in order to refine and improve their programming.</p>
<p>PE -Dance (Explorers) The unit of work will develop pupil's ability to create and develop their characters, adding movements, expression and emotion to their performance. The children will be able to create a motif and will develop their motifs with a partner to include some different elements of choreography.</p>	<p>PE- Gymnastics (linking) The unit will challenge pupils to explore different ways that they can link movements and balances together while travelling along a variety of pathways. They will create and refine a sequence on apparatus while travelling along a chosen pathway.</p>
