We had some surplus 'cash to splash' due to various deposits not being needed due to things not taking place as usual. We are delighted to let you know we are paying for the training for two new forest school teachers – Ms Stratton and Miss Pugh. This will mean Forest School can open up to even more years! We are also buying some microphones and doing-up the AV equipment in the school hall in time for the year 6 production and starting the fund for the next Legacy project below...

Next Legacy Project:

The Core Committee have agreed that the next legacy project is going to be a moveable room e.g. Shepherds Hut. This is to be based on the school driveway where the minibus is. As we all know, indoor space in schools is at a premium and by providing this hut we will be able to instantly give the children another space for clubs, music lessons, a breakout area and pastoral care. We would love to achieve this aim by September 2021. We are costing it up at the moment but a key potential cost saving is labour and materials... which means...
